### *Safety Rules for the Sport of Archery*

2. NEVER shoot an arrow straight up into the air. You can end up hitting another person or yourself.
3. NEVER shoot an arrow off into the distance where you cannot see where it will land. You could end up hitting another person.
4. If you are looking for a lost arrow behind a target, leave your bow leaning against the target face so it can be seen or have
