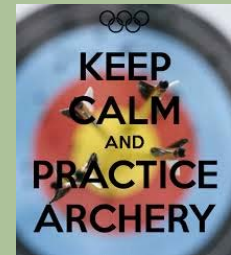
REMINDER - There are no Broadheads allowed on the range!
